Explanatory Note: First and second generation Irish numbered 128,000 in 1930. However, since the number of first and second generation in this group amounted to over 200,000 in 1870, we can assume the present number of 400,000 for first, second, third and some fourth generation Irish of today.

The number of Yankees is more or less a rough estimate made after all the other ethnic groups had been discounted from the total present population of Connecticut.

Double; the number of first and second generation Germans has been assumed to be a rough estimate of the total number of Germans in Connecticut.
